Manuel Gausa Navarro is Full Professor of Urban Design and Urban Planning since 2017 at the Department of Architecture and Design, University of Genoa (ADD-UNIGE) where he was also Full Professor of Landscape Architecture / Architectural Design from 2015 to 2017 and Associated Professor on Architectural Design from 2008 to 2015.

Coordinator of the ADD, PhD in Architecture and Design at the Department of Architecture and Design (DAD-UNIGE - University of Genoa) directs the GIC Lab, Research laboratory in architecture, urbanism and landscape.

Co-founder of IAAC, Institut d'Arquitectura Avancada de Catalunya, from 2003 to 2006 he was President of its Scientific Committee and from 2012 to

2015, its Scientific Dean. He is currently Lead Professor in Advanced Knowledge Theory and Member of the Scientific Committee as IAAC-Senior Founder.

From 1995 to 2000 he was Professor of Design at the Escola Tècnica Superior d'Arquitectura de Barcelona - Universitat Politècnica de Catalunya (ETSAB-UPC). He was also a founding member, Vice-Cultural Director and Professor of Architectural Theory and Design at ESARQ-UIC- Escuela Superior de Arquitectura de la Universidad Internacional de Catalunya (1997-2001).

Over 300 lectures and lectures in prestigious institutions related to architecture and culture in general, the commitment to innovation, training and the transmission of ideas have prompted an active participation in teaching, research and knowledge transfer in various foreign universities. The GIC-Lab-UNIGE (Genoa Intelligent Cities, Informational Contexts, International Courses) is a transversal research laboratory (Decree DIPARC-UNIGE, February 24th 2010) which has as its theoretical objective –and as a specific area of project interest– the understanding and interpretation of contemporary urban, architectural and landscape space, understood as a *complex and relational multi-scenario*; and its relationship with the current conditions of simultaneity, complexity and informational diversity.

Associated with the GIC-Lab, the LUAD-UNIGE research line is developed, co-directed by Manuel Gausa since 2012. The formulation of new tools for the analysis and new devices for the design of architectural and landscape planning, is the basis of a research that aims to identify new paradigms of redevelopment, reorganization, recycling and reactivation, urban and territorial. New networked integrated systems –intertwined at the territorial level and renewed at the urban level – for the new geo-urban and also intro-urban dimension of the contemporary city.

The study of the n-city (or multi-city) is the basis of its objectives, aimed at promoting the integration between multiple and plural systems, at different scales and levels of reading and approach; spatial, functional and

environmental; exploring and integrating complexity, celebrating and articulating diversity; favoring and impelling in the project a positive interaction between scales and levels, data and processes, programs and uses, contexts and realities; through new spaces – new scenarios – transversal (territorial, urban, landscape, architectural and social) in tune with a new relational (open) and informational (advanced) logic.

## **LAND-LINKS & MULTI-CITIES**

### **New urban strategies, new design approaches**

The program of research and design LAND-LINKS & MULTI-CITIES wants to deepen in the new dynamics associated with the trinomial *Logic-Organization-Formulation* (or, in another way, *System-Order-Form*) at different levels and scales of reading and intervention – territorial, urban, landscape, architectural -- with an apothecary attention to parameters of simultaneity, complexity, mixity, intersection and exchange (programmatic, typological, morphological, occupational, etc.).

- on the urban and / or territorial scale (on-line schemes and strategic and geourban developments)
- on the landscape and environmental scale (synergy with the surroundings, resilience and eco-mediation)
- on the architectural scale (mixed programs and new integrated / integrating units)
- on the collective scale (approaches to public space and its co-participatory role)
- at the socio-cultural scale (exchange and transversal energies, space-time activism)

The territories – and scenarios – of the complex development of the city, in its different forms and urban, architectural and landscape declinations – and in particular the multi-urban cost scenarios as paradigmatic contexts of these processes – constitute the main fields of research and in-depth study on to develop the theoretical reflections and the perspective and design analyzes of the GIC-Lab. Its action program develops simultaneously through different levels of reading and approach, conceptual and design. His research – and didactic – program develops through leap-scale processes; exchange and multi-scalar synergy.

- On a geo-urban and inter-urban level

Ensuring a qualitative, integrated and integrative development – 'in network' and 'between networks' eco, intra, infra and info structural – of the city and / in the territory (crossed matrices 'density, landscape, infrastructures', etc.)

- Urban and multi-urban level

Conceiving a more diversified and intense multi-systemic approach for our spaces of life and exchange, understood as relational scenarios (fields or landscapes of forces) rather than as simple volumetric, building or real estate sets. Favoring the cross-over between multi-level cross-connection networks associated with re-naturalization, urban reactivation and



recycling; but also a new meeting between urban resilience and intelligence in a *n-city* interpreted as a 'place of places'. Impulsing, therefore, the search for possible integrated flexible matrices (diagrammatic synthesis diagrams) but also of nodal spaces (node locations) intended as multiple 'conduction and condensation' scenarios; inducing scenarios where to elaborate possible multi-level design approaches, proposing a supra and anti-typological definition of the landscape-architectural space itself, based on the combination, crossing and / or hybridisation of programs, uses and structures (mixed programs and spaces of complex life and relationship in 'residence-production-recreation' scenarios).

– At a meta-urban level

Favoring an urban, architectural and landscape conception capable of responding to the culture of one's own time; able to build relationships and interactions - more than just forms and objects - in space ... and between spaces (theory and practice, architecture and transversality).

Associated with these premises 3 MED-NET International Congresses have been promoted (Med-Net 1-2011, Med-Net 2-2012, Med.Net 3, 2016) and 3 International Congresses Rebel Matters (Rebel Matters I-2010, Rebel Matters II-2013, Rebel Matters III-2017) as well as more than 120 interventions in international congresses, 103 articles in national and international journals and monographs and the publication of 33 scientific books.
