### *Teaching activity*

The teaching of the courses of Administrative Law and Public Sector and Public Bodies Accounting is aimed at providing the theoretical foundations of the principles and rules governing the functioning and management of public subjects, their role in social and economic organization, the instruments through which they intervene in economic and social life as well as their ways of interaction with the institutions and subjects of the non-public world.

In particular, in the Accounting course the aspects described are particularly detailed with regard to their economic and financial component linked to the management of public resources.

In order to allow the educational contents to be analyzed on issues raised by the evolution of the discipline or by contingent contexts of a regulatory or economic nature, the teaching activity of the courses is enriched by the contribution of experts in the field who hold roles or hold special positions in the Public Administrations and give students the dimension of the application complexity of the issues subject to theoretical discussion within the course.

With the same aim, part of the teaching activity on specific topics takes place in the technical structures of the Public Administrations, where alongside the theoretical exposure we are able to make concrete examples of the applicative return of the concepts covered by the course's lessons.

### *Research interests*

The field of interest of the research activities is mainly directed to the area of management detection systems, acquisition and management of the financial sources and of the rules for the administration of resources by the Public Administrations.

The subjective perimeter of the specific activities concerns in particular the sub-central levels of government with particular regard to the territorial entities, their aggregated subjective forms, the bodies of the health sector and other smaller public entities.

In particular, the object of the specific lines of research concerns:

- accounting models used by Public Administrations and the design and production of components, or alternative models, of an innovative nature to be implemented as a result of regulatory reforms referring to new subjective or regulatory frameworks
- comparative researches on the use of sources and financial instruments for the management and investment needs of public entities;
- definition of institutional models for the management of public / private partnership initiatives;
- analysis of economic and financial sustainability and analysis of legal feasibility and management sustainability of initiatives and projects of

public administrations
