Research interests

My main lines of research: a) the municipal magistrates of ancient Italy; b) the Roman army; c) the imperial cult in Rome; d) the political and institutional life of some municipalities of Roman Italy; e) espionage systems in Rome; f) scholarship and studies on ancient historiography in seventeenth and nineteenth century Italy. My most recent lines of research concern the divinities connected to curative thermalism, problems inherent to the Roman family, characters linked to the archaic period of Rome, the Roman Senate, arbiter of political-administrative disputes during the second century. BC, the recovery of episodes linked to monarchical Rome in Italian literature of the fourteenth century and in Italian painting of the sixteenth century.
